- Michigan Sportsmen Against Hunger (MSAH) is an all-volunteer 501(C3) organization dedicated to supplying venison to help those in need within Michigan. Our board of directors represents ten Safari Club International chapters, Michigan Bow Hunters Assoc., Michigan United Conservation Clubs, National Deer Assoc., and Ted Nugent's United Sportsmen of America.
- During the 2023-24 season over 113,000 lbs. of venison was distributed by MSAH and since its beginning over 1,000,000 lbs. of venison has provided over four million nourishing meals to thankful people in our communities.
- Beginning in 2005 MSAH contracted to administer the Sportsmen Against Hunger program for the Michigan Dept of Natural Resources (MDNR). As of September 30, 2024, the Michigan Sportsmen Against Hunger contract with the MDNR Sportsmen Against Hunger program expired and was not renewed.
- Up to September 30, 2024, funding from generous donations made by individuals during the purchase of hunting and fishing licenses paid the cost of processing and distribution of this venison.
- MSAH is no longer funded by Hunting and Fishing license application donations so therefore MDNR collected dollars are not available to us.
- Venison donated and processed through the MDNR program will continue to be x-rayed for metal contamination and checked for chronic wasting disease and bovine tuberculosis. Following these examinations the venison will be distributed through the Food Bank Council of Michigan network of seven food banks to participating charities.
- MSAH recognizes that there are many deer processors across Michigan who do an excellent job of handling venison for their customers and friends. MSAH will work with respected deer processors who wish to maintain local control and will voluntarily sign a Sanitation Guidelines Agreement to provide a reliable source of venison to charitable groups in their community.
- MSAH will provide as much financial assistance as possible through donations from our supporters to participating processors coupled with creating awareness of the important contributions from these deer processors and our financial supporters.
- All processor reimbursements and public awareness efforts including MSAH communications will show credit to our financial supporters.
- Please help Michigan Sportsmen Against Hunger to continue to feed those in need by providing financial support and donating a deer. A list of participating processors will be maintained on our website.
